Got time to spare and the urge to explore the Mammoth Cave Area? Check out some of the interesting and fun places there are to be found if you know where to look!

## *Tuesdays Mornings in Logan County!*

Be sure to call first for your early morning visit to Licksillet 1779 and enjoy touring their demonstration gardens as well as greenhouse horticultural products, natural craft workshops, garden accessories and gift items. Need some quality fresh, locally-grown produce, fruits or crafts? Stop next at the Logan County Farmers Market. Open noon until 4:00pm, this open air market is sure to appeal to the all your senses. Getting hungry but want a little more history? Head to South Union a late lunch at the 1869 Shaker Tavern then spend the afternoon exploring the historic Shaker Village (1807-1922). The Shaker Museum, found in the 40-room 1824 Centre House, is filled with scores of original artifacts exemplifying the Shaker's fine craftsmanship.

## *Sleeping with Shrimp in September!* *(weekend trip)*

Feel like a relaxing weekend get-a-way? Spend the morning stocking up on supplies. First stop - Habegger's Roadside Market. Stock up on items such as: quality meats and cheese, homemade butter, seasonal farm produce, baked goods, honey, candies, ice cream and more. Then head over to Quail Hollow Candles & Gift Shop for a different kind of shopping with all kinds of candles (make your cabin smell good!), handcrafted gifts, antiques, Amish items & more. While you are there stow everything in your cooler and explore the working Candle Factory with live candle carving demos. Getting hungry? When you arrive at River's Edge Rental Cabins situated on the Cumberland River unload your goodies, fix up a picnic basket and enjoy the peace and quiet! The next day you can make a short trip to Buck Acres Freshwater Shrimp in Fountain Run (Shrimp harvest is the last weekends of September) and visit the two 3-acre ponds, one of Kentucky's largest shrimp operations. Stock up on fresh jumbo shrimp and what a feast you will dine on tonight! Rather catch your own and save the drive? Top off your afternoon fishing for your own dinner in the river instead!

## *Green Thumb Lover's Day!*

Located in peaceful Edmonson County only miles from Mammoth Cave National Park, Mammoth Cave Transplants has 14 growing greenhouses on 100 acre cattle farm allowing visitors to go into greenhouses and choose the plants they like for home and/or garden. Pick from a large variety of plants, ferns, and flowers. While you are so close drive on over to Mammoth Cave National Park and have lunch at either the Crystal Lake Coffee Shop or the Traveline Restaurant located in Mammoth Cave Hotel. Ready to tweak your thumb some more? Then head south to The Garden Patch a 250 acre dairy farm with a garden shop, outbuildings with antiques and three greenhouses full of seasonal flowers, herbs and perennials and see nature in bloom.

It is best to call first (781-4101) so you can start your morning off at Tenito's Country Kitchen selling a wide variety of baked goods - sourdough breads, cinnamon rolls, pies, cakes and jams, all made fresh. But do not worry if they are not available because you can still satisfy your sweet tooth at your next stop! Chaney's Dairy Barn offers udderly delicious ice cream made at the barn. Visit with a modern-day farm family, have a chance to see ice cream production from the cows to the cone, take a hay-ride or browse their Kentucky Gift Shop. Got sweets already but need lunch? They offer homemade soups, sandwiches and desserts also! To finish filling up your stomach head to Jackson's Orchard for fresh apples, peaches, pumpkins, honey, freshly made apple cider and more in-season specialties.
